1. Gardet Brut Tradition NV Chigny-les-Roses, Champagne

Altogether fresh on the nose, the palate fills and richens with every sip, a sign of the extra mature wines added. A full-bodied consistency, fine acidity and a balance between creamy roasted nut and brioche flavours and bold, steely acidity.

2. Nyetimber Classic Brut - England

15

Lovely pale gold in colour with a fine bead. This Blanc de Blancs shows Nyetimber's classic signature of delicate floral and citrus aromas followed by subtle vanilla and toast flavours, but now with a pure crystalline core thanks to the inclusion of Chardonnay from their Hampshire vineyards. A long complex finish makes this a wine to be savoured.

3. Prosecco D.O.C., Pure - Veneto, Italy

The nose gives aromas of pear, white flowers and lemon zest. The palate is clean and crisp with apple notes, leading to a light and refreshing finish.

Bright and pale, slightly satin pink. A delicate wine with hints of white flowers on the nose. Expressively fresh on the palate, with a good acidity.

13. Picpoul de Pinet, Terre d'Eole - Languedoc, France

9.75

Brilliant yellow robe with green tints. Flower nose with notes of hawthorn, acacia, but also citrus fruit. Round and mineral wine in the mouth with a grapefruit finish.

15. Sauvignon Blanc, Le Charme by Christine Cabri - IGP Pays du Gers, France

8.50

A fabulous aromatic wine, fresh on the nose with flavours of citrus fruit combined with blackcurrant leaf aromas and a great roundness.

16. Vermentino, Coquille de Mer - Languedoc, France

8.50

Pale lemon in appearance with citrus, apricot and gentle floral aromas. Ripe peach, and tropical notes on the palate. A fruity easy drinking style with good, balanced acidity. Crisp and refreshing.

19. Pinot Grigio, Ca' Tesore - Venetie, Italy

8.50

The nose has hints of lemon balm, green apple and pear and the palate is dry and zesty with vibrant floral notes.

25. Pitchfork Chardonnay-Southern Eastern Australia

8.70

A fresh, unoaked Chardonnay offering incredible value for money. A world away from the over-oaked, buttery fruit-bombs of 15 years ago!

36. Malbec, Hornhead - Languedoc, France

9.25

Deep dark red. Beautiful flavours of dark fruits, amplified with hints of coffee, cocoa and subtle rosemary. Wonderfully harmonic with a round and juicy mouthfeel.

37. Grande Reserve Bush Vine Dry Grown GCM, Jean Didier - IGP d'Hérault, France

9.25

On the nose there are aromas of plum jam, raspberry, spice and a touch of pepper, not dissimilar to a good Cotes-du-Rhône. The palate is soft and smooth with a ripe red fruits, and a touch of pepper on the finish.

39. Rioja Tempranillo, Bodegas Muerza - Rioja, Spain

9.25

An elegant red wine with hints of liquorice and dark fruit both on the nose and the palate. Well-structured and easy to drink due to a low level of tannins.

44. Pinot Noir, Lautarul, Cremele Recas - Banat, Romania

9.25

Dark in colour, red plum, cherry and mulled spicy aromatics. Beautiful flavours, almost jammy in its concentration. Layers of complex black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon, with a long and lingering finish.

- 46. Shiraz, Pitchfork - South Eastern Australia** 9.25
Bright with colour and aromas of plum and red currant over toasty mocha and spicy oak. The palate is full flavoured with plum, blueberry and mocha notes. The tannins are well balanced and give the wine great structure and length..

- 1. Gardet Brut Tradition NV - Chigny-les-Roses, Champagne** 75
Altogether fresh on the nose, the palate fills and richens with every sip, a sign of the extra mature wines added - the palate grows in the glass and seems more expressive and elegant, with a full-bodied consistency, fine acidity and a balance between creamy roasted nut and brioche flavours and bold, steely acidity.
- 2. Nyetimber Classic Brut - England** 75
Lovely pale gold in colour with a fine bead. This Blanc de Blancs shows Nyetimber's classic signature of delicate floral and citrus aromas followed by subtle vanilla and toast flavours, but now with a pure crystalline core thanks to the inclusion of Chardonnay from their Hampshire vineyards. A long complex finish makes this a wine to be savoured.
- 3. Prosecco D.O.C., Pure - Veneto, Italy** 35
The nose gives aromas of pear, white flowers and lemon zest. The palate is clean and crisp with apple notes, leading to a light and refreshing finish.
- 4 .Nyetimber Rosé - England** 110
A beautiful sunset pink colour. Aromas of red fruits with intriguing spice notes of anise and lavender. The palate has a creamy round texture with redcurrant, raspberry and cherry flavours. An elegant, silky finish.

- 5. Cinsault Rose, Coquille de Fleur - IGP Pays d'Oc, France** 28
This rosé is a light and fresh wine, with fruit-forward aromas. It displays notes of wild raspberry and candied strawberry. The palate is lively and well-balanced, with mineral elements echoing on the finish.
- 6. Rioja Rosé, Bodegas Bagordi S.L. - Rioja, Spain** 34
Bright and pale, slightly satin pink. A delicate wine with hints of white owers on the nose. Expressively fresh on the palate, with a good acidity.

- 7. Sancerre 'Le Pierrier', Domaine Jean Thomas - Loire, France** 58
Brilliant light yellow. Expressive nose of grapefruit, apple, pear and floral undertones. Lively attack flowing into a suave, full and fresh palate with crisp aromas. Well-balanced, focused and elegant.
- 8. Chablis, Domaine des Marronniers - Burgundy, France** 75
Bright gold in appearance. Complex aromas of yellow peach, melon, Mirabelle plum, floral narcissus, peony, almond paste, cinnamon, white pepper. A well balanced palate between the dominant fruity flavours and floral notes. A persistent and fresh finish with highly intense peppery notes.
- 9. St Véran, Vers Les Monts, Domaine Roger Luquet - Burgundy, France** 65
A very floral, hedgerow nose, upfront and direct leading to a stewed apple and almond butter palate. Ripe in the mouth, lovely soft texture and crisp steely acidity.
- 10. Château d'Argadens, Sauvignon Blanc - Semillon - Bordeaux, France** 43
A delicious bouquet of ripe, tropical fruit with notes of melon, pineapple, gooseberry and Golden Delicious apple. The palate is wonderfully concentrated with a clean citrus streak that keeps the wine energetic and vibrant, all supported by a delicious note of oak that adds weight and structure.
- 11. Chenin Blanc, Mineralium - Languedoc, France** 36
Bright and pale yellow in the glass. The nose displays hints of green apple skin, citrus fruit and fresh cut grass. This bone-dry white shows terrific balance, with refreshing acidity and minerality. The limestone mouthfeel is supplemented by juicy grapefruit aromas on the finish.

12. Marsanne-Viognier, Deux Grives, Xavier Roger - Languedoc, France	40
Gold and bright in colour. On the nose, candied apricots and peaches with notes of honeysuckle and lemon peel. Full bodied with a long refreshing finish.	
13. Picpoul de Pinet, Terre d'Eole - Languedoc, France	40
Brilliant yellow robe with green tints. Flower nose with notes of hawthorn, acacia, but also citrus fruit. Round and mineral wine in the mouth with a grapefruit finish.	
14. Grenache, De Visu 172, Xavier Roger - Languedoc, France	43
Rich and expressive with notes of white peach, mango and a touch of lime blossom.	
15. Sauvignon Blanc 'Le Charme', Christine Cabri - IGP Pays du Gers, France	33
A fabulous aromatic wine, fresh on the nose with flavours of citrus fruit combined with blackcurrant leaf aromas and a great roundness.	
16. Vermentino, Coquille de Mer - Languedoc, France	33
Pale lemon in appearance with citrus, apricot and gentle floral aromas. . Ripe peach, and tropical notes on the palate. A fruity easy drinking style with good, balanced acidity. Crisp and refreshing.

17. Albariño, Alba Vega - Rias Baixas, Spain	46
Clean and fresh with delicate citrus notes on the nose and a palate packed with green apple, orange peel and lime flavours. Its a simple wine at first, but there is definite complexity - perfect for the BBQ or the white clothed dining table.	
18. Tempranillo Blanco, Rioja Vega - Rioja, Spain	45
On the nose, complex, expressive, with intense notes of tropical fruits and white flowers over delicate aromas of herbs. Unctuous and sweet attack on the mouth which develops into fresh citrus flavours. A subtle silky texture from the ageing on its fine lees in French oak barrels. A complex wine which will keep well for many years to come.	
ITALY	
19. Pinot Grigio, Ca' Tesore - Venetie, Italy	33
The nose has hints of lemon balm, green apple and pear and the palate is dry and zesty with vibrant floral notes.	
20. Gavi 'I Risi', Mario Giribaldi - Piemonte, Italy	55
Pale straw in colour with the right degree of green fleck and limpid appearance. A full fresh nose with stone fruit notes and a degree of citrus, the palate offers layers of crisp dessert apple, pear and almond nut. Full and round in the mouth with a discrete structure and clean yet 'fresh as a daisy' finish. A light acidic note, typical of this wine makes it a pleasure to drink with all varieties of food.	
21. Toscana Bianco Sangiovese, Duca di Saragnano, Barbera - Tuscany, Italy	35
Brightly and clearly straw yellow colour. A fresh sour cherry, orange blossom and broom enhance the aromatic complexity of this wine, while hints of quince linger in the background. Rich on the palate and on its minerality, pleasantly fresh, harmonic and slightly savoury.	
GREECE	
22. Cuvee Prestige White, Domaine Skouras - Peloponnese, Greece	45
The colour is bright white yellow, with green hues. The nose is complicated and the wine smells of fresh flowers, hints of pressed blossom and fruit. Flavours of orange and lemon blossom prevail with touches of jasmine and mint.	
SOUTH AFRICA	
23. Jonty's Duck, Avondale - Paarl, South Africa	50
The nose displays pure fruit; lime, grapefruit and pineapple with just a dash of honey. The palate is dense with ripe flavours and juicy with tangy peach and apricot flavours, delivered with good intensity and freshness.	
24. Chenin Blanc 'Anima', Avondale - Paarl, South Africa	60
Anima has a nose that develops intriguingly in the glass. Winter melon, pineapple, lime and a hint of honey confirm the elegance and fullness of this softly wooded, supple Chenin Blanc. The palate is dense with fresh fruit flavours of gooseberry, quince and peach, all harmonising superbly with the soulful minerality that gives this wine its name.

25. Pitchfork Chardonnay-Southern Eastern Australia	33
A fresh, unoaked Chardonnay offering incredible value for money. A world away from the over-oaked, buttery fruit-bombs of 15 years ago!	

NEW ZEALAND

- 26. Pinot Gris, Domain Road - Central Otago, New Zealand** 50
Pears and stonefruit dominate the bouquet, together with hints of quince. The sweet taste of pears and peaches comes through on the palate. This medium bodied wine has a good texture and fine balance.

CHILE

- 27. Gewürztraminer 'Reserva', Alto Los Romeros - Central Valley, Chile** 35
Characteristically floral and spicy, this wine is a perfect match for Asian food.

ARGENTINA

- 28. White Malbec, Santa Rosa - Mendoza, Argentina** 35
The nose has hints of lemon balm, green apple and pear and the palate is dry and zesty with vibrant floral notes.

Rare & Vintage

- 56. Meursault, Domaine Bernard Michelot - Burgundy, France** 145
The wine offers notes of honey, baked apple strudel, racy lime curd and fresh acidity, all balanced by a tight minerality that adds to the wines presence and structure. This is a great intro to this fine appellation.

- 57. Châteauneuf du Pape, Domaine du Vieux Télégraphe, Domaine Brunier - Rhone, France** 245
More floral than fruity aromas, and characterised by balance and freshness. A brilliant, gorgeous golden hue with green hints. There are aromas of pear, laced with anise and fennel on the bouquet. The palate is rich, creamy and complex with a touch of oak and overtones of apricot with an underlay of anise. This is a member of the classic school of white Châteauneuf du-Pape, more floral than fruity aromas, and characterised by balance and freshness.

- 58. St Andrews Riesling, Wakefield Estate - Clare Valley, Australia** 85
The wine is a very pale straw colour with a slight green tinge. The nose shows zesty lemon and lime aromas along with faint orange blossom. This Riesling has fresh lemon/lime juice characters and a slate-like minerality across the mid-palate. It is backed up by a persistent and refreshing lime finish.

RED WINE

FRANCE

- 29. Bourgogne Hautes Cotes de Beaune 2020, Domaine Machard de Gramont-Burgundy, France** 58
The colour is lighter, with more typical fragrance of cherries, herbal essence, farmyard and raspberry. The palate is riper, more rounded and sweeter in style, with notes of spice, woodsmoke and suppleness in the mouth. Very good with a subtle freshness that really livens the finish and mid palate.

- 30. Morgon 'La Croix Gaillard', Domaine Pardon - Beaujolais, France** 52
This vintage with deep red and purple notes, has aromas of black fruit such as cassis, floral notes and spice. Fleshy and generous, the palate is powerful and structured with a delicious intensity of cassis fruit richness.

- 31. Fleurie, Domaine Pardon - Beaujolais, France** 52
The nose displays ripe strawberry character with notes of fresh hedgerow fruits. The palate is light and soft with wonderful texture and elegance. Smooth and supple this is a great example of modern, fruit forward Beaujolais.

- 32. Château Moulin de Mallet - Bordeaux, France** 41
This super little Château situated on the plateau of Pujol, a rocky outcrop overlooking the Dordogne and facing the slopes of St Emilion. Owned and run by Serge Couderc and his son Julien who manage the estate, following "lutte raisonnée" principles, they always look to take low yields hence the intensity of concentrated fruits This château has been the source of our leading 'Every Day Claret' for a number of years and provides exceptional quality at a very attractive price. Always very expressive, it screams ripe black fruit aromas on the bouquet, whilst the palate is brimming with succulent mulberry and plum fruits, supported by a soft, underpinning tannin structure.

- 33. Côtes du Rhône Villages, Les Arbouzes, Massif Uchaux - Rhone, France** 39
Produced by winemaker Marc Thomas who is meticulous in using the different appropriate vinification methods available for each different parcel of Grenache, Syrah and Carignan vines. A lovely fruit packed wine.

- 34. Crozes-Hermitage Cuvée L, Domaine Laurent Combier - Rhone, France** 53
This wine is deep purple in colour, powerful and opulent on the bouquet that screams ripe plum characters. The palate is very rich with multiple layers of chocolate and liquorice.

- 35. Minervois Rouge Tradition, Pierre Cros - Minervois, France** 45
The bouquet is complex with fragrant red and black fruits and spicy overtones. The palate is smooth and full bodied, beautiful and velvety in texture with a delicious spice giving an extra dimension.

36. Malbec, Hornhead - Languedoc, France	35
Deep dark red. Beautiful flavours of dark fruits, amplified with hints of coffee, cocoa and subtle rosemary. Wonderfully harmonic with a round and juicy mouthfeel.	
37. Grande Reserve Bush Vine Dry Grown GCM, Jean Didier - IGP d'Hérault, France	35
On the nose there are aromas of plum jam, raspberry, spice and a touch of pepper, not dissimilar to a good Cotes-du-Rhône. The palate is soft and smooth with a ripe red fruits, and a touch of pepper on the finish.	
38. Grenache, De Visu 223, Xavier Roger - Languedoc, France	39
Overt and spicy aromas with a hint of white pepper, the palate is concentrated with ripe black cherry fruits and liquorice intensity. The varietal character shines through with an underlay of garrigue and a spicy herb finish.

39. Rioja Tempranillo, Bodegas Muerza - Rioja, Spain	35
An elegant red wine with hints of liquorice and dark fruit both on the nose and the palate. Well-structured and easy to drink due to a low level of tannins.	
40. Rioja Crianza, Vega - Rioja, Spain	40
A bright, fruit driven Rioja with notes of cherry and cassis and a soft vanilla edge from the oak. Smooth, soft and fruit driven.	
PORTUGAL	
41. Coroa d'Ouro, Manoel Poças - Douro Valley, Portugal	38
Ruby with a dark core. Clean and fruity notes, with layers of mulled black berry, cherry stone and a wonderfully crunchy, classy baked cherry pie, balanced on a nerve edge of freshness and refined brooding power.... Full-bodied, aromatic and elegant.

42.. Corvina IGT, Zeni - Veneto, Italy	39
Bright ruby red in appearance with aromas of fruit and spice. Intense and persistent palate.	
43. Nero d'Avola, Rupe Secca - Sicily, Italy	33
Intense and smooth red wine, full of ripe red berry (sweet cherry, baked plum, damson and raspberry coulis) aromas and flavours supported by soft tannins

44. Pinot Noir, Lautarul, Cremele Recas - Banat, Romania	33
Dark in colour, red plum, cherry and mulled spicy aromatics. Beautiful flavours, almost jammy in its concentration. Layers of complex black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon, with a long and lingering finish.	
SOUTH AFRICA	
45. Jonty's Duck, Avondale - Paarl, South Africa	45
On the nose there is lots of blackcurrant and liquorice, with a hint of dark chocolate and ground coffee. The wine has an explosion of creamy red fruits on the palate and well integrated, elegant tannins to support it.	
AUSTRALIA	
46. Shiraz, Pitchfork - South Eastern Australia	32
Bright with colour and aromas of plum and red currant over toasty mocha and spicy oak. The palate is full flavoured with plum, blueberry and mocha notes. The tannins are well balanced and give the wine great structure and length.	
CHILIE	
47. Carmenere Gran Reserva, Santa Luz - Colchagua Valley, Chile	35
Smooth and rich with blackberry, sweet spiciness, nuances of tobacco and a silky long finish.	
USA	
48. Old Vine Zinfandel, Smoking Loon - California, USA	44
Juicy aromas of plum, raspberry and mocha. On the palate, cherry, pomegranate and clove dominate. In the background, dill and vanilla hints.	
ARGENTINA	
49. Malbec, Mendel - Mendoza, Argentina	68
Displaying the typical aromas of mature fruit, plums, raisins and violets, with full-bodied, meaty flavors.	

Rare & Vintage

59.Nuits-Saint-Georges Vieilles Vignes , Machard de Gramont - Burgundy, France	110
There is black fruit aplenty, concentrated and intense, with a muscular and powerful frame of fruit, tannins and spice. This is a dense and structured Pinot, showing all the power of Nuits, but with a sweetened core of fruit that wells up from the glass to mask the weight of the wine. Long, powerful, very good.	
60.Château Bonalogue, Pomerol - Bordeaux, France	180
This wine is deep purple in colour, powerful and opulent on the bouquet that screams ripe plum characters. The palate is very rich with multiple layers of chocolate and liquorice.	
61.Château Grand Mayne - Grand Cru St Émilion, Bordeaux, France	200
Big, rich and intense with red currants and cherries giving freshness to the massive plum fruit intensity. A wine of great finesse and elegance.	
62.Château Léoville Barton 2ème Cru, St Julien - Bordeaux, France	240
The bouquet is classic Medoc , smouldering with hints of cedar and cigar box, whilst the palate is powerful and packed with delicious cassis fruit.	
63.Château Clément-Pichon, Haut-Médoc - Bordeaux, France	95
A very impressive, overt bouquet with dark fruits and a touch of stewed plum. The palate is soft and linear with a well defined structure. Rich in creamy black fruits with an emphasis on cassis and cedar, the tannins are firm and there is a refreshing balance. The finish is long and lingering, round and stylish. What great value this is!	
64.Amarone della Valpolicella doc Barriques, Zeni - Veneto, Italy	110
Deep ruby red in appearance. Full-bodied, with hints of black cherry and well-ripened fruit on the nose. Rounded, full-bodied and velvety on the palate.	
65. Barolo, Giribaldi - Piemonte, Italy	85
A ruby red colour with amaranth reflexes, an evident perception of good red fruit appeals to the nose, dried berry and chocolate fruit with Nebbiolo's signature perfume of rose petals and coffee. Full body with soft silky tannins and a juicy finish.	
66. Brunello di Montalcino, Col di Lamo - Tuscany, Italy	152
Deep red with purple reflections, the bouquet is harmonious, with notes of plum and blackberry and finely woven oak aromas. The palate is brooding and rustic and packed with dark black fruits, forest floor and an underlying hint of cinnamon and cloves. The palate is deliciously plush and the finish soothing and long. An outstanding wine.	
67. Old Vine Shiraz, Irvine Estate - Barossa, Australia	140
Bright ruby red, with a nose full of expressive cherries, blackberries, liquorice and coffee. A rich medium to full bodied palate with hints of chocolate and dark cherries. Soft tannins with persistent flavour and great length.	
68..Pinot Noir 2020, Longboard, Russian River Valley - Sonoma, USA	125
Deep red. Lively red fruits and rose oil and a touch of earthiness on the perfumed nose. On the palate, gently sweet cherry and black raspberry flavours are lifted by tangy acidity and a hint of white pepper. Closes up a bit on the gently tannic finish, leaving notes of vanilla and bitter chocolate behind.

69.Aszú 5 Puttonyos, Grand Tokaj (50cl) - Tokay, Hungary	17	95
Tokaji Aszú derives its rich, copper colour and depth of sweetness from Botrytis-affected grapes, with its intense aromas and flavours of honey and apricots.

Lots of raisin, fig and prune hints with a powerful sweetness at its core. In the mouth it has lots of dark fruits and some toffee hints. A great port for all year round.
